

# **“REVELATION: READY OR NOT...?!”**

**WEEK #5: “WORTHY IS THE LAMB!”**

**SCRIPTURE: REVELATION 5:1-7 (Read as a Group)**

- 1. What does the word “Worthy” mean?**
  - a. Why is Jesus referred to as “The Lamb,” and what is He worthy of?”**
  - b. Have you ever received something that you felt you were unworthy of, but received it anyway, how did you feel? Explain!**
  - c. Why did the scroll have seven seals, and what was meant by “no one in heaven, or on earth or under earth” was found worthy to open it?**
  - d. In the first 6 verses of Rev 5, Jesus is called the “Lion of Judah” and the “Lamb.” What are the significance of Jesus being both? What are the major differences between the lion and the lamb?**
  - e. What did John mean by “Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing at the center of the throne?” Did he see a Lamb or did he see Jesus, or one and the same?**
  - f. Who took the scroll, and why do you think John makes it clear that the scroll was in God’s “right hand?”**
  - g. Why did John “Weep,” who told him to stop weeping, and why?**

**SCRIPTURE: REV 5:8-14 (Read as a Group)**

- 2. Who did John see worshipping the Lamb at this time?**

- a. The creatures and the elders “sang a new song” of worship. What is the new song, and what was the “old song,” and what marked the need for a new song of worship?
  - b. What are the elders now holding, and why? Read Daniel 7:22 & 27
  - c. According to the elders, what, or whom did the Lamb purchase, and how?
  - d. Where will the newly redeemed reign?
  - e. Who sang the 3<sup>rd</sup> song of praise, and how many did John hear singing, and what did they sing?
  - f. What is the significance do you think of John repeating the phrase “in heaven, on earth, and under earth” in verse 13? What does heaven, earth, and under earth represent?
  - g. The words “Glory, honor, worthy, praise, power, wisdom, and strength” are all used in the songs of praise, why? Do you use these words when you worship God in private? If those in heaven sing these words, shouldn’t we?
  - h. What do the 7 horns and 7 eyes represent on the Lamb, and why 7?
  - i. Who sings the new song in heaven and who does not sing the new song and why?
  - j. The 7 golden bowls represent what, and who are they meant for?
3. What did you learn today about the Book of Revelation Chapter 4 that you didn’t know before?
